George Alogoskoufis is the Constantine Karamanlis Professor of Hellenic and European Studies at the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University.

He is on leave from the Athens University of Economics and Business, where he has been Professor of Economics since 1990.

He is also a Research Associate of the Hellenic Observatory of the London School of Economics and Political Science and a Fellow of the European Economic Association (EEA).

From September 1996 until October 2009 he was an elected member of the Hellenic Parliament and from March 2004 until December 2008 he served as Greece's Minister of Economy and Finance.
